Stuffed with turkey, tired of shopping? Join 4RK9s for a day of Nosework fun. Can you tell when your dog is sourcing odor, just sniffing for themselves or checking out a distractor? Come spend the morning or afternoon (or both) with Johnnette Ulch, UKC and AKC judge, to work on your ability to recognize the difference. Watch multiple dogs and their changes of behavior on odor versus a distractor. This seminar is geared toward teams competing or preparing to compete in any level that has distractors (UKC-Superior, NACSW-NW2, AKC-Advanced). Distractors will be those commonly used at UKC, NACSW and AKC trials. Odors used will be Birch, Anise and Clove. Bring your phone or other video recording device and we will help you capture your runs.

There are 2 separate workshops. The morning workshop will be at the 4rk9s club building. Weather permitting, the afternoon workshop will be offsite somewhere in the Cedar Rapids area for Exteriors and Vehicles, and a point-to-point exercise. (If weather does not cooperate, the afternoon workshop will be at the 4rk9s building.) The afternoon session will meet at the 4RK9s building to start and then travel to an exterior location.
