A fee of \$25.00 will be levied for a returned check. All entries must be submitted on Official UKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and will not be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit card payments cannot be accepted. Entries sent by overnight mail must not require a signature. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judge or veterinarian, barred from competition by action of the show committee or UKC. No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency or any other cause beyond the control of the show committee (except for state or UKC COVID-19 restrictions enacted after trial has opened). Refunds will be given if trial cannot be held because of COVID-19. Refunds will be given for bitches that come in season after the closing date of the trial minus a \$5.00 handling fee with a veterinarian's certificate prior to the start of the trial.

This is a tentative running order. It is subject to change or adjustment based on the actual number of entries received and/or weather conditions.

To limit the number of persons at the trial site at the same time because of COVID-19, start times for the various element levels will be sent with final confirmation letters a few days before the trial.

SITE ADVISORY: Be aware that the Ulch farm may require walking on uneven footing in outdoor grassy areas, and contains grassy inclines/small hills that will need to be navigated to reach the search areas. Uneven footing and/or inclines may be present in the search areas (grassy field/lawn on a small hillside).

COVID-19 ADVISORY: Masks and/or facial shields required whenever 6-foot social distancing cannot be maintained. Masks and/or facial shields highly recommended at all times you are interacting with others during the trial searches or in the parking lot.

Trial Information

Handlers need to plan to work from vehicles.

No camping is available at the trial site.

Move-ups will be allowed. Move-ups for Saturday's trials must be received by the Trial Secretary by Monday, Oct. 5, 2020. Move-ups for Sunday must be turned into the trial secretary before you leave on Saturday.

Food

Lunch will not be provided for competitors. This is a rural location about 1 mile east of Belle Plaine. Belle Plaine has a couple of fast-food options if needed.

Notice to Exhibitors

"A" Section Classes - This section is open to all exhibitors and dogs that have not earned a title in the element in which they are entering or equivalent title in another organization. The exhibitor must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner's household or immediate family. Once the dog has earned the title they may no longer compete in the "A" section. No licensed or professional dog trainer or Nosework instructor, regardless of the person's status as an amateur or professional, may compete in this section. No person licensed to officiate Nosework in UKC or any other organization may compete in this section.

Exhibitors with more than one dog entered in a trial. Exhibitors may handle only one dog in each class, or element in each trial. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog in the same class or element so long as a separate handler is provided for each dog. Exhibitors may enter and handle more than one dog per trial provided the additional dog(s) are entered in a different class or element from all other entries being handled by that exhibitor.

A UKC registration number is required to participate in these trials. For information on UKC registration go to www.ukcdogs.com.

Ribbons and Placements

Placement ribbons will be provided for 1-4 placements in each class. Blue qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. New title ribbons will be offered for anyone earning a new element title. Rosettes also will be offered for those individuals completing their full level titles.
