Her young female "Saucy" is competing at Crufts in March 2012. Bridget has had a dog (sometimes two) ranked in the AKC Top 25 All Breed Obedience Dogs in 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008. She is also an accomplished field trainer putting Master Hunter (MH) titles on five dogs.
